More people will be needed to sit on the Tribunal. An advert will be put out to see who might be interested to be on the Tribunal.



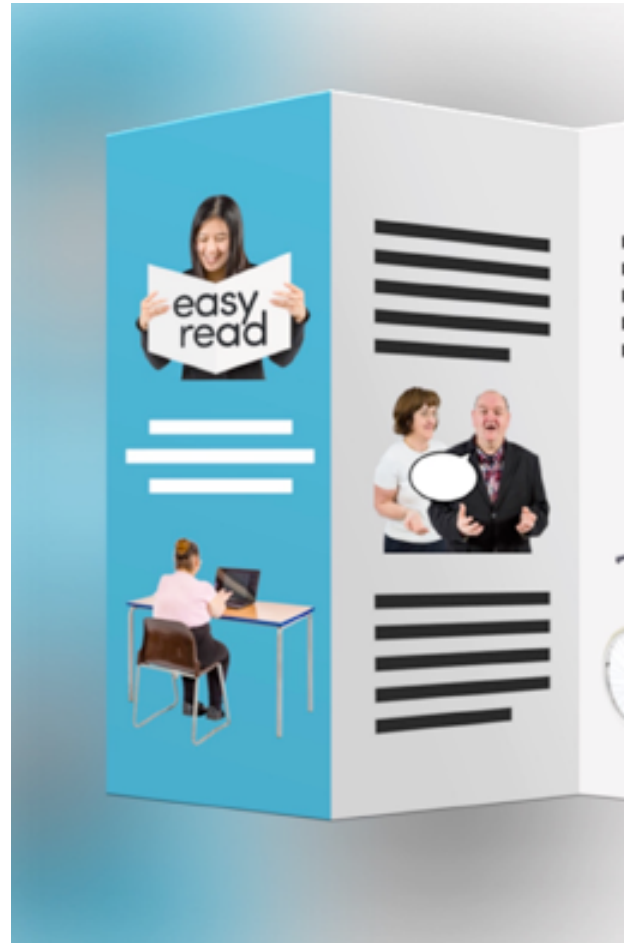
